Demolition Derby Rules

(adopted 2/8/2020)

MINI VANS

No passengers allowed, a cage is mandatory and halo bar is recommended. Vans shall be mini vans, NO full-size vans and NO full frame or flat nose vans.

EVERY DRIVER WILL HAVE TO SUPPLY A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OR YOU WILL NO BE ALLOWED TO ENTER.

The (2) front down bars cannot go past the firewall. You cannot put leaf springs under a coil spring frame or coils under a leaf spring frame. May only be four- or six-cylinder engines.

Rules are the same as **MODIFIEDS, EXCEPT FOR THE FOLLOWING:**

Shock Tubes

Can be 10" long 3' x 3' x 1/4" thick. From the bumper back.

Gas tank protector and Halo

1. The gas tank protector can be as wide as the inside floor pan of the van and stop at the front of the wheel wells in the floor pan.
2. Can be bolted or welded to the frame in (2) spots total.
3. You cannot have kickers to the frame behind the a-arms or kickers at all.

Fuel Tank

1. Stock gas tank must be removed.
2. An auxiliary steel tank or designated plastic fuel tank maximum (6) gallon capacity (a portable marine tank is recommended) must be placed on the floor pan and securely fastened to the floor pan.
3. It must be located midline left side behind driver's seat and no further forward than front of rear axle and completely covered with a fireproof covering.
4. Electric fuel pumps must have a **LIGHTED** on/off switch located within driver's reach and labeled.

Doors

1. Use modified rules except back door can weld 1" and leave 6" between welds or wire or bolt.

Windshield wire

1. Must have at least (1) bar which may be welded on or a twisted #9 wire attached to the middle of the windshield area to prevent hood from coming in.
