

# RICHLAND COUNTY FAIR DEMO DERBY RULES

## OLNEY, IL

(These are the same rules they are using at Fairfield, Albion, Mt. Carmel, and Iuka)

**THESE RULES APPLY TO ALL CLASSES** see each individual class for more rules pertaining to that class (adopted 2/28/2022)

WE HAVE THE RIGHT TO RE-INSPECT, CUT, OR DRILL ANY CAR AT ANY TIME. IF YOU ARE CAUGHT BREAKING THE RULES SET HERE FORTH YOU WILL FORFEIT ANY AND ALL WINNINGS AND OR PRIZES YOU ARE DUE. **JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL.**

- Drivers and passengers must remain in the vehicle with helmet, seatbelt, and eye protection on until notified by an official that it is safe to exit the vehicle.
- Driver's door hits are illegal. If the hit is deemed by the official to be careless or intentional, you will be disqualified. If you use your driver's door as a defense, we will not enforce the rules. If you use the door defense repeatedly you will be disqualified.
- No hot rodding in the pits. Keep it at an idle.
- Any open door will cause disqualification. You are allowed one fire, second fire will be cause for disqualification.
- Sandbagging is not tolerated and will be strictly enforced. Locking up the brakes prior to a hit for anything other than a driver's door will be cause for disqualification. The fans pay to see a show, so put one on for them!
- YOU MUST MAKE AGGRESSIVE HIT EVERY 60 SECONDS (1 MINUTE)!
- You will be given ample time for restarts. We do not use the clock exclusively. We try to work with you if you are hung up. Hitters get more time than sandbaggers.
- THERE IS NO ALCOHOL IN THE PITS. This includes pit crews. If any of your crew is caught with alcohol you will be disqualified.
- All money or trophy winners are subject to post race inspection before any prize money or trophy is awarded.
- No harassing of the judges will be allowed at any time by the drivers, passengers, crewmembers, or spectators. Failure to abide by this rule, the driver will be disqualified, and all involved will be escorted from the premises.
- All drivers and passengers must be 16 years or older. Must have a valid driver's license, or state issued ID, if 16 years old must have parent or guardian present to complete waiver to participate in the derby!!!!
- NO PROFANITY OR VULGAR LANGUAGE OF ANY KIND CAN BE DISPLAYED ON THE VEHICLE!!!
- NO FLAGS CAN BE PLACE ON THE VEHICLE!!!!
- MUST HAVE 18" X 18" WHITE PLATE WITH BLACK NUMBER MOUNTED ON THE ROOF RIGHT BEHIND TOP OF WINDSHIELD. If you don't have one, we will supply you with one at a cost of \$20.
